As of January 1st, 2023, the City of Pomona Building and Safety Division began enforcement of the 2022 California Building Codes for all new residential and non-residential construction projects. Projects submitted after January 1, 2023, shall comply with the new codes.

**Local Design Criteria:** (ASCE7-16)

**Seismic Design:** Category 'D', 'E' or 'F' as determined by USGS Maps and CBC Chapter 16

**Wind:** (ASCE7-16)

**Rainfall:** 2"/hr.

**Climate Zone:** 9

**Flood Zone:** X

**Risk Category I:** 89mph, Exposure 'C'

**Risk Category II:** 96 mph, Exposure 'C'

**Risk Category III:** 102 mph, Exposure 'C'

**Risk Category IV:** 107 mph, Exposure 'C'
