**Pool and Spa Anti-Entrapment Cover Certification**

Revisions to the **California Health and Safety Code Section 115920**, known as the Swimming Pool Safety Act, came into effect January 1, 2007. Section 115928, subsection (d) states that “whenever a building permit is issued for the remodel or modification of a single family home with an existing swimming pool, toddler pool, or spa, the permit shall require that the suction outlet of the existing pool, toddler pool or spa be upgraded so as to be equipped with an anti-entrapment cover meeting current standards of the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) or the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME).”

For homes that have a swimming pool, toddler pool, or spa, the anti-entrapment device **must be installed prior to final inspection approval**. For homes that do not have a swimming pool, toddler pool, or spa we request that the owner so declare on this form.
