### **MAJOR DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS - MAY 2021**

Below is a summary of recently submitted major development projects within the City.

 Project: National Core project Location: 501 E Mission Council District: 2 - Preciado

**Description:** The proposed project is an L-shaped structure on the corner of Mission Blvd. and Palomares Street. The development includes 60 residential units and 15 live/work units for artist for both families and artists. Of the 75 units, 74 units will be reserved for affordable housing to households earning less than 60% of the area median income and one exempt unit reserved for an on-site manager. The proposed site plan includes on-site parking and a centralized courtyard.

2. **Project:** Elephant Hill project

**Location**: 2889 West Mission Boulevard (APNs: 8707-020-001/8 and 8707-021-058)

**Council District**: 5 - Lustro

**Description:** The project includes an application for a Specific Plan, Change of Zone, and Tentative Tract Map for the property located at 2889 Mission Boulevard, commonly referred to as Elephant Hill, consisting of the area at the northwest corner of Mission Boulevard and Humane Way. The project site is currently undeveloped and occupies approximately 120.6 acres, east of the 57 Freeway, south of I-10, and west of Highway 71. The proposed project consists of 227 residential units, specifically 68 two-story dwellings, 94 two-story duplexes, and 65 three-story townhomes. The project will require approximately 35.6 acres to be graded and/or developed, with 17.35 consisting of residential area and 18.25 consisting of open space. The project will incorporate as many as five

architectural styles: Transitional Spanish; Agrarian Modern; Contemporary Ranch; California Cottage; and, West Coast Prairie.



### EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency

Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.


