PUBLIC WORKS

PARKS AND FACILITIES MASTER PLAN

After months of anticipation, the County has finally executed the agreement for the Los Angeles County Safe, Clean Neighborhood Parks and Beaches Measure of 2016 (Measure A) grant funding in the amount of \$250,000 to create a Citywide Parks and

Facilities Master Plan (Master Plan). The Master Plan will provide the City with an analysis of the existing conditions and needs at each of its 28 parks, including the condition of the facilities, community centers, and programming. Preparation of the Master Plan will include a number of community meetings that will give the residents an opportunity to provide valuable input regarding parks and facilities' needs in the City. The Master Plan will also include a financial strategy analysis, an analysis of the feasibility of new park development, a level of service cost analysis, and identification of funding sources for park development, maintenance and administration. This document will be an essential tool that will be utilized to help the City improve its parks and facilities. The City has engaged RJM Design Group, Inc. for the preparation of the Master Plan.

FREE COMPOST GIVEAWAY EVENT - July 17th

The Public Works Department held its last compost giveaway event on Saturday, July 17, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the City Yard located at 636 W. Monterey Avenue. Residents who participated were limited to four 32-gallon containers.

Waste Management provided 10 cubic yards of compost. The remaining compost will be used by the Parks and Facilities Division, as needed.

CA RENT RELIEF PROGRAM NOW OPEN!

As of March 15, 2021, both renters and landlords can check for eligibility and apply for CA COVID-19 Rent Relief. EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

APPLY NOW-FEDERAL COVID-19 FUNERAL REIMBURSEMENTS

FEMA is accepting applications for financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020. Please call 844-684-6333 (TTY: 800-462-7585) or visit the <u>FEMA website</u> for eligibility and the checklist for documents –such as official death certificate, receipts, etc. If you are eligible for funeral assistance you will receive a check by mail, or funds by direct deposit, depending on which option you choose when you apply for assistance.
