SUMMER 2021 PROGRAMMING RECAP

Community Services was thrilled to offer a variety of exciting, fun, FREE and memorable programs, camps, events and experiences this summer. Pomona residents had the opportunity to enjoy four Movies in the Park with their families at Philadelphia Park, Ganesha Park, Jaycee Park, and Ralph Welch Park.

Participants of the 3rd annual Heroes of Pomona Speech Contest wrote and gave speeches on how their Pomona hero made a positive impact in their life and/or in Pomona. Approximately \$2,000 in scholarships were awarded.

Below are a list of the one to two week specialty camps that were offered this summer:

- **H2O Camp** 42 youth participated in fun water activities.
- **Pomona Art Camp** 48 youth created original art and admired art at Downtown Pomona.
- **Sports Camp** 22 youth were introduced to the fundamentals of a variety of sports, teamwork, and social skills.
- Life Skills 101 Camp 15 teens learned essential life skills such as financial literacy, healthy lifestyle choices, college/career exploration, and being a responsible vehicle owner.
- Young Writers Camp 12 youth enhanced their writing skills through a variety of activities and field trips.

In partnership with YMCA of Greater Long Beach, Community Services provided 74 youth with a FREE week long residential camp experience in Big Bear at YMCA Camp Oakes. In addition to having the camp be free, Community Services staff intentionally tried to overcome barriers to participation by offering several parent information meetings in English and Spanish, providing transportation to and from camp and offering new sleeping bags to those campers who needed them.

Thank you to all of our partners in helping make this a safe and successful summer for Pomona's youth and families! Partners include Bright Prospects, City of Pomona Fleet Services, Day One Pomona, LA County Parks and Recreation, San Dimas Canyon Nature Center, The dA Center for the Arts, Tri-City Mental Health Services, UC Riverside's Inland Area Writing Project, US Bank, and YMCA of Greater Long Beach-YMCA Camp Oakes.

CITYWIDE AQUATICS



EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.
