CODE COMPLIANCE

NUISANCE PROPERTY AT 966 W. FIRST STREET

The single-family residence at 966 W. First St. has been a long standing nuisance for Code Compliance and the community. Pomona Police Department has also received frequent calls for service regarding illegal activity at the property. Code Compliance conducted progressing enforcement on the property including issuance of correction notices, Administrative Citations and conducted several abatements, resulting in placement of a lien on the property. The property however continued to be in a state of disrepair and a public nuisance.

Code Compliance recently referred the property to the City Attorney for possible Receivership in an effort to return the property to Code Compliant condition and mitigate negative impacts on the surrounding neighborhood. With the assistance of the City Attorney, Code Compliance and Building Department issued the property owner a Legal Notice & Order to Repair or Abate.

As a result of these progressive measures, the property owner sold the property prior to the compliance deadline (09/09/2021) on the Legal Notice & Order to Repair or Abate.

The new property owner is an investor who is exploring rehabilitation and improvement options for the property. The owner has cleaned up the property and secured it from unlawful entry. The owner has also filed the NO TRESPASSING authorization letter with Pomona Police Department.

The City received a check for last week from an Escrow Company for all outstanding lien/abatement and citation costs on the property.

Code Compliance will continue to monitor the property and make sure the new owner follows through and obtains all necessary permits required to repair and rehab the property.

SECURE TRASH CAN LIDS

One of the City's goals is to reduce waste and provide essential, daily trash pick-up service. The Public Works Department has dedicated Staff that provides educational material to residents regarding refuse service and the proper placement of containers curbside. This week, a bill insert will be mailed to residents on the importance of securing lids on each container placed curbside for service.

The bill insert will read as follows (English/Spanish):

Working Together To Make Pomona Safe and Clean



SECURE TRASH CAN LIDS - Please help keep Pomona safe and clean by ensuring that all solid waste containers or bins left outdoors and placed curbside for servicing have the lids closed at all times. With the lid closed, the containers/bins are secured and reduces unwanted pests, unlawful disposal and scavenging, and protects trash from rain. Securing the lids on the container/bins prevents trash from spilling out onto the sidewalks and streets, creating hazards to health and safety. This is required by Pomona City Municipal Code Section 62-812 and can be found by visiting <u>www.pomonaca.gov</u>.

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The <u>FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit</u> will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.
