RETURNING TO AFTER SCHOOL RECREATION

The FREE After School Recreation Program has recently returned to six locations (one in each district), offering youth ages 7-17, with opportunities to participate in activities such as health and fitness, arts and crafts, sports, games, STEAM activities, and homework assistance. As the City is committed to operating safe in-person recreation programming during the pandemic, participants must pre-register before attending. Once registration has been successfully submitted, a City staff member will contact the parent/guardian to discuss program requirements and confirm enrollment. As a COVID-19 safety precaution, there are limited amount of participants served, therefore an attendance requirement of four days a week is in place. PROGRESSIVE COMMUNITY PARK FIELD TRIP

On Saturday, September 25, 2021, Community Services staff will take youth, along with a parent/guardian on all-day field trip to multiple park/playground destinations. Participants will have the opportunity to explore and play at each destination. The City will provide transportation, lunch, snacks and water. The group will travel as far north as Alameda Park's Kids World in Santa Barbara. The purpose of the trip is to obtain input from youth and adults on the type of park and playground amenities they would like to see included in the City's Civic Center Plaza park project. This information will also help with the development of future playgrounds, parks and grants.

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.
