INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

IT NETWORK CYBERSECURITY TESTING

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) recently tested the City's Network Infrastructure and the Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA) division for vulnerabilities. Their analysis concluded that the Pomona's network fared better than other cities tested. Our firewalls and virus security endpoints blocked 100% of the phishing, viruses and ransomware attacks that they initiated. The CISA team indicated that no other city performed as well.

POLICE DEPARTMENT PATROL MDT UPGRADE

IT and the Police Department have ordered 45 new Dell MDCs to support the Patrol, Detective and Quality of Life, Parking, Report Writers, Major Crimes Task Force and K9 units. The new units will replace current MDC's that have reached their end of life. Installation of the new units and docking mounts will be taking place beginning in January.

STAFF CYBER SECUTITY TESTING & TRAINING

The IT Department is currently evaluating training and testing software. Our goal through this training process is to allow staff hands on practice at recognizing and avoiding a wide range of security risks. Once testing and training is complete, each member will receive a cyber-security certificate.

LIBRARY COMPUTERS

IT completed the installation of new computers in the Library. In total there were 28 new computers installed, 4 – in the children's area, 6 - in the teen center, 13 - in the Computer Lab, and 6 - in the adult reference center. All of the computers are running upgraded software, Windows 10, Microsoft Office 2019 on a Microsoft Windows 2019 domain. Pay to print has also been redesigned and upgraded.



PRO HOUSING POMONA – 6TH CYCLE DRAFT HOUSING ELEMENT



ART PROGRAM FOR WEST VALLEY CONNECTOR PROJECT - SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY (SBCTA) OMNITRANS

As part of the West Valley Connector Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) service linking the City of Pomona in Los Angeles County with the cities of Montclair, Ontario and Rancho Cucamonga in San Bernardino County there will be an art component at each station stops. The SBCTA Board will issue an RFQ for artist services and has requested each City along the route designate a representative to serve on the art selection committee to represent the City of Pomona. The Cultural Arts Commission appointed Commissioner Jovani Esparza as the representative to serve in this capacity. The artwork will include artwork on the utility boxes and station panel at each station stop. The RFQ is anticipated to be released in early 2022.

PUBLIC WORKS

SR-71 EXPRESSWAY TO FREEWAY CONVERSION PROJECT: OVERNIGHT FULL CLOSURE OF NORTHBOUND LANES

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) <u>announces</u> a full freeway closure of northbound State Route 71 (SR-71) from the SR-71/SR-60 interchange to Mission Boulevard on Friday, October 1 for K-rail installation and striping work. The scheduled closure is part of the new SR-71 Expressway-to-Freeway Conversion Project. OHL USA, Inc. is the contractor on this \$174.55 million project. This project is funded by Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017.

The project will add one mixed-flow lane and one High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane in each direction converting the existing 4-lane expressway to a full 8-lane standard freeway. The project will smooth the roadway, extend the highway life by as many as 40 years and enhance traffic safety with highly reflective lane stripes and road markers, improved shoulders, new guardrails, sound walls, retaining walls, and concrete barriers.

Closures are as follows:

Friday, October 1

- Northbound SR-71 from SR-71/SR-60 interchange to Mission Boulevard closed from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Northbound SR-71 Rio Rancho Road on-ramp closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Westbound SR-60 to northbound SR-71 connector closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Residents and businesses located near the freeway are advised to anticipate noise, vibrations, and dust associated with construction activities.

The schedule is weather-permitting, and all dates and times are subject to change.

Detours will be posted. Motorists should expect delays and are strongly advised to avoid the area and use alternate routes. Additionally, motorists can check traffic conditions before they leave by visiting the Caltrans <u>Quickmap</u> (quickmap.dot.ca.gov).

Caltrans reminds motorists to "Be Work Zone Alert" and "Slow for the Cone Zone."

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.
