DEVELOPMENT OF THE FY 2022-2023 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

The City of Pomona is in the process of developing its FY 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan. Annually, the City receives entitlement funding through the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the following programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). The Plan will outline the amount of funding available and activities that may be undertaken to meet housing and community development needs.

As a condition of receipt of these funds, staff is consulting with the following stakeholders to solicit their input on the City's needs:

- Community Residents
- Community Organizations Serving Residents
- Council Members
- Commissions
- Pomona Continuum of Care Organizations
- Pomona's Promise Group
- State and Local Health Agencies
- Public Housing Agencies

To ensure citizen and stakeholder participation in the development of the Action Plan, outreach efforts will include mailing informational postcards to over 44,000 households citywide, informing them of community meeting dates through various platforms, requesting their input via a Community Needs Survey and notification of Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) to assist in providing services to residents. PROJECT WEBSITE LAUNCHED FOR PARKS AND FACILITIES MASTER PLAN

In May 2021, City Council approved a resolution to create a Parks and Facilities Master Plan and awarded an agreement with RJM Design Group to assist with the preparation of the plan. The plan will provide the City with an assessment of existing conditions of its parks and facilities, identify the community's recreation needs, prioritize recommendations, and generate a plan for long-term maintenance, improvement, and development of the City's parks and facilities. The plan is expected to be completed in July 2022.

Through April 2022, public outreach will be conducted through a number of community workshops, stakeholder interviews, a sports organization questionnaire, and a community survey. A project website has been launched to provide updates, collect data, and obtain valuable community feedback. PUBLIC WORKS

STREETLIGHT VANDALISM

Over the course of several weeks, the City has experienced an increase of vandalism to streetlights from copper wire theft. Recent vandalism ranges from stealing wires from street light circuits to breaking into service pedestals and turning the breaker off so the entire neighborhood is affected.

- Garey / Reservoir / Philadelphia / County
- Westmont Area
- Garey Ave. between Olive and County
- Mission Blvd. between Phillips to Temple Ave.

The Public Works' Traffic Operations Division is working diligently to repair damaged circuits, fixtures and associated impacted infrastructure. These repairs are time-consuming and costly. As a result, some areas may experience street light outages for several weeks before repairs are completed. We thank you in advance for your patience regarding this matter and remind you to call the Pomona Police Department if you witness vandalism in progress or suspicious activities around street light fixtures or infrastructure. EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The <u>FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit</u> will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

FEMA is accepting applications for financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020.
