

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

IT RECEIVES HIGH NETWORK SECURITY RANKING FROM CISA & HOMELAND SECURITY

The City's IT Network was recently tested for vulnerabilities by the Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA) Division of Homeland Security (DHS). The Network fared better than any other city tested. City firewalls and virus security endpoints blocked 100% of attacks attempted by the Agency. The CISA team indicated that Pomona was the highest performing city tested.

POLICE DEPARTMENT PATROL MDT UPGRADE

The Police Department, in conjunction with IT, will be replacing end-of-life MDTs, for several work units. Installation of the new units and docking mounts will be completed over the next several months.

VIDEO SURVEILLANCE NEW AND UPGRADES

Pomona IT is scheduling upgrading and repositioning several Police Department perimeter surveillance cameras. Thirteen Community centers will also benefit from camera upgrades and repositioning, to deter theft and vandalism. IT has also arranged for quarterly maintenance for all cameras to ensure that cameras are cleaned, directed and properly adjusted. IT is also enhancing connectivity at each site to enable PD viewing and video downloads remotely from these locations.

STAFF CYBER SECURITY TESTING AND TRAINING

IT is evaluating training and testing software to provide Staff with hands on practice at recognizing and avoiding a wide range of security risks. This enhanced training will better position the City to avoid and combat potential future security threats.




PUBLIC WORKS

STATE ROUTE 71 OVERNIGHT FULL CLOSURE

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will conduct a full road closure of State Route 71 (SR-71) between Rio Rancho Road and Mission Boulevard. The closure will begin at 10:00 p.m., Sunday, December 12th and end at 5:00 a.m. on Monday, December 13, for utility line relocation.

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.
