## **PUBLIC WORKS**

#### CLEAN CALIFORNIA LOCAL GRANT PROGRAM AWARD

The City is excited to announce that Pomona has been awarded \$4,922,041 from the Clean California Local Grant Program managed by Caltrans. Clean California makes significant investments in litter collection, community engagement, and education to ultimately transform unsightly roadsides into spaces of pride for all Californians. This was a competitive grant program with Caltrans receiving more than 300 applications from across the State. The City's application was one of 105 applications selected for funding. The City will utilize the funding to beautify and enhance the safety and walkability along Holt Avenue, from Garey Avenue to Mills Avenue, and along Garey Avenue, from Holt Avenue to Mission Boulevard. The project will include:

- Enhancing hardscape by repairing sidewalks and improving ADA accessibility,
- Adding additional lighting/replacement of existing lighting with LED,
- Adding a jogging trail and exercise equipment at Garfield Park,
- Installing trash receptacles and solar trash compactors on every block,
- · Adding lighting and murals to the Garey Ave. and First St. underpass,
- Providing additional bus shelters, where needed,
- Adding art to trash receptacles and electrical boxes,
- Adding anti-littering signage throughout the area,
- Tree planting, and

• Funding eight beautification events to be facilitated by Pomona Beautiful, a nonprofit organization dedicated to beautifying the City.

All improvements and activities shall be completed by June 2024. This is an exciting opportunity to improve the Holt Avenue Corridor and complements other efforts the City is undertaking along Holt Avenue to beautify and enhance the overall safety of the area.

# <u>NEW!!! MOBILE PHONE PARKING APP – FLOWBIRD/CALE</u>

The City of Pomona has just launched a mobile payment option for daily parking in the City owned <u>Downtown</u> <u>Parking Lots</u> (not for on street parking). This service is provided by Flowbird/Cale, the City's parking payment Kiosk Company. For an additional processing fee of \$0.35, a mobile phone may be used to pay for daily parking at any pay lot. The total cost will be \$2.35, which includes the standard \$2.00 per day parking fee from 8 a.m. to 8 a.m. of the next morning, and an additional \$0.35 service fee for the mobile pay option.

This is how it works. Download the Flowbird Application. Create an account, using an email or login using Facebook. Find where you are parking on the map generated on your phone (the location is also posted at each kiosk). Choose your parking duration. Enter your



credit card details. Finally, click "Pay", you're done.

Instructions are also posted on each applicable parking payment kiosk, as well as on the <u>City's web site</u>.

#### EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit (The Affordable Connectivity Program replaced the Emergency Broadband Benefit on December 31, 2021) will provide a discount of up to \$30 per

month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

FEMA is accepting applications for financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020.
