FIFTH ANNUAL SPRING EGG HUNT | APRIL 9, 2022

Due to the pandemic, the City's annual Egg Hunt event was canceled in 2020. In 2021, the Division offered a COVID-19 safe alternative called Snap a Spring Selfie at Washington Park. Community Services is excited to bring back the <u>Easter Egg Hunt</u> for its fifth year! This FREE event will be held on Saturday, April 9th concurrently at four Pomona parks (Philadelphia Park, Westmont Park, Garfield Park, and Kennedy Park). Community Services will partner with a variety of community organizations (e.g. The dA, Project Sister, Village Academy, Cal Poly Kellogg Honors College, and Project Horseshoe Farm) to create a fun, safe, and family-friendly event.

Games and activities, as well as a visit from the Easter Bunny will begin at 9:00 a.m. The Egg Hunt will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m. with 12,000 eggs being distributed between the four parks! The participants will be separated into three different age groups, serving children 11 years and younger. In each age group area, there will be a hidden golden egg. The lucky child who finds the golden egg will be given a special basket.

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit (The Affordable Connectivity Program replaced the Emergency Broadband Benefit on December 31, 2021) will provide a discount of up to \$30 per

month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

FEMA is accepting applications for financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020. Please call 844-684-6333 (TTY: 800-462-7585) or visit the <u>FEMA website</u> for eligibility and the checklist for documents —such as official death certificate, receipts, etc. If you are eligible for funeral assistance you will receive a check by mail, or funds by direct deposit, depending on which option you choose when you apply for assistance.
