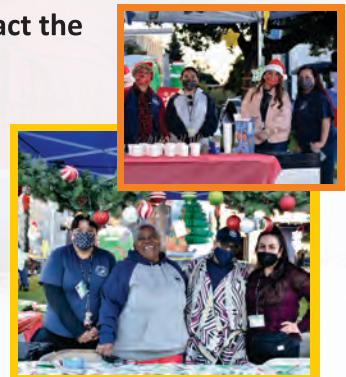

**SUBSTANTIAL REHABILITATION
LOAN PROGRAM**

The Program helps provide funding for low income homeowners with a deferred, low interest rehabilitation loan. The loan is available to help correct code violations, address health and safety issues, and improve the condition of the property.

The property must be an owner-occupied, single-family home located in the City of Pomona.

Eligible improvements include, but are not limited to the following:

- Exterior/Interior Painting
- Electrical wiring
- Roof Repair & Replacement
- Kitchen Remodeling
- Repair/Replace Heating
- Modifications for Handicapped

**LEAD EDUCATION AWARENESS
CONTROL & HEALTHY HOMES
(LEAC+HH) PROGRAM (GRANT)**

Is there peeling or chipping paint on your property? Was your property built prior to 1978? **If so, you might qualify for FREE assistance under the LEAC program.**

The LEAC Program was created to provide lead-based paint testing and lead paint hazard removal assistance to prevent lead poisoning in homes with younger children. To qualify a child 6 years and under or an expectant mother must visit or reside in the home.

Typical lead work involves removal of chipping or peeling paint and repainting areas of your home may include:

- Exterior and/or interior
- Door and Door Frames
- Wood Windows and Frames
- Eaves, Rafters and Fascia boards

“Lead Safe” home for your family/tenants to live in.

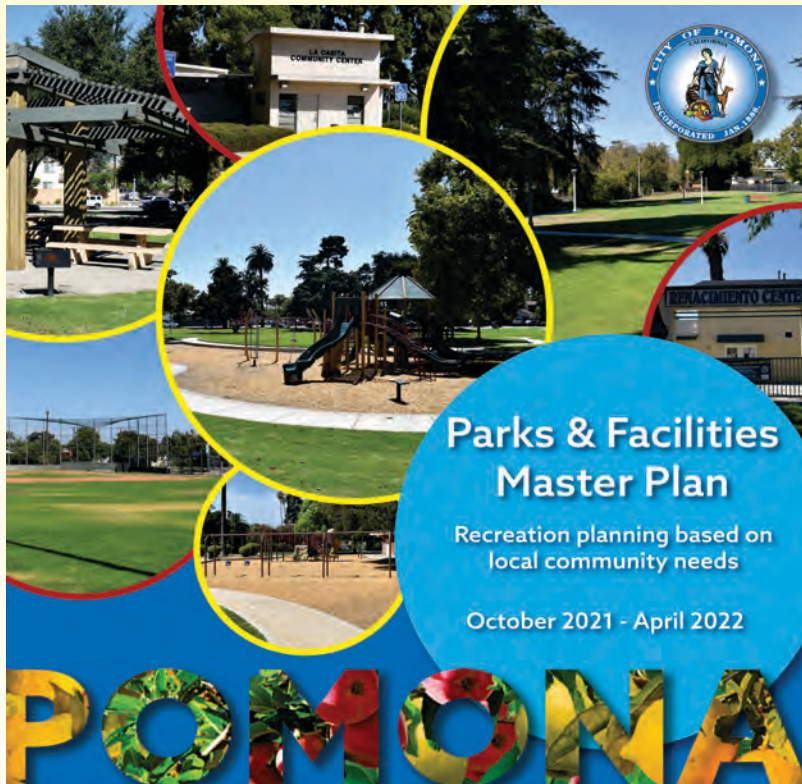

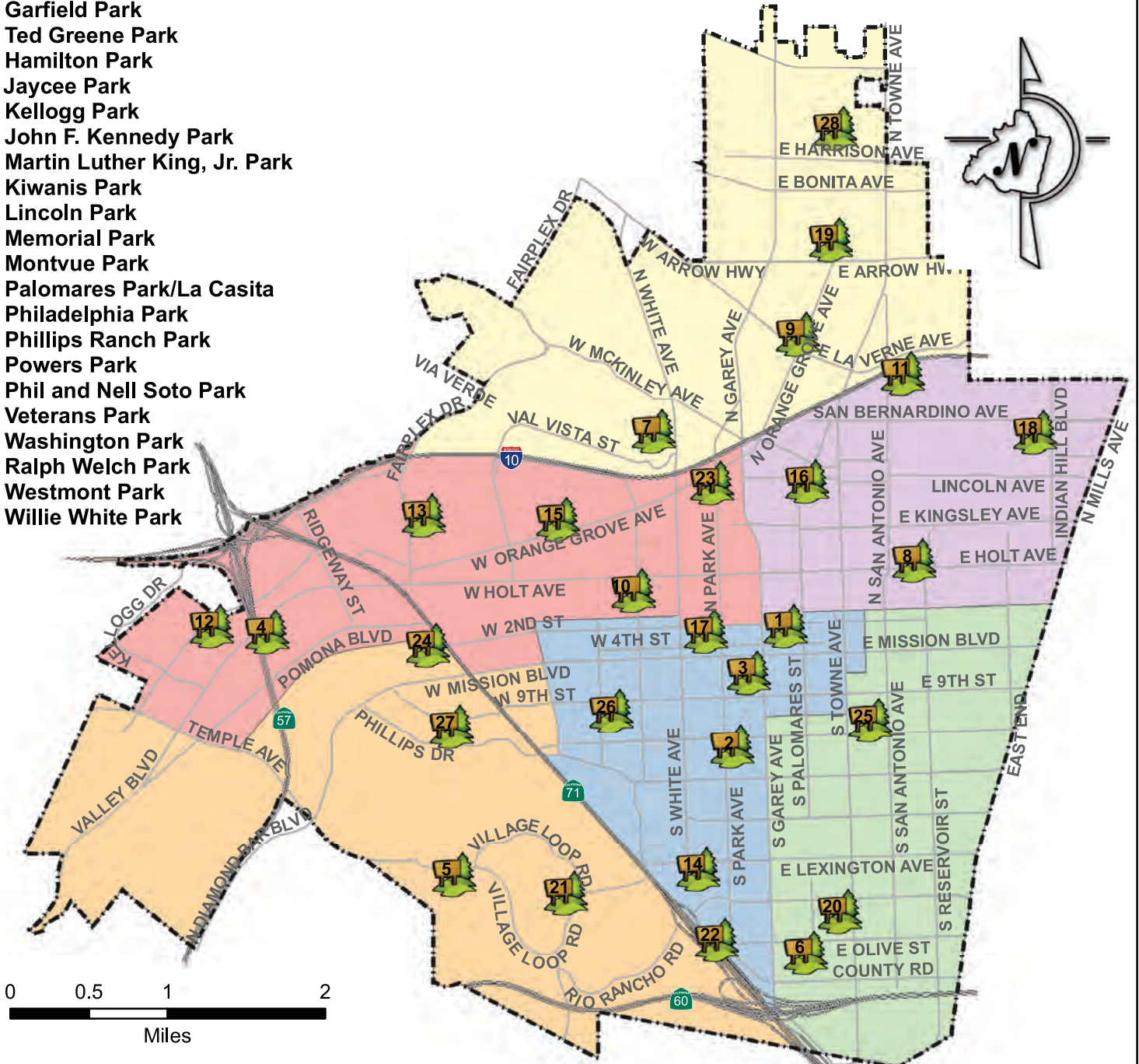
