<u>RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY AND GRAND OPENING — VALLEY</u> BOULEVARD BIKEWAY MARKERS

The highly anticipated Class IV Bikeway Markers along Valley Boulevard, from Temple Avenue to Humane Way, have been installed.

Join us for the Grand Opening and Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for this First Class IV Bikeway in the City of Pomona, on March 25, 2022 at 11:30 a.m. at Valley Boulevard and Kellogg Drive. Parking will be available courtesy of our SCE partners at the northwest corner of Valley Boulevard and Kellogg Drive (enter Kellogg Dr. from Valley Blvd. then first left to parking.)

This work is part of the City's "Major Street Rehabilitation – 2015 Metro Call", Project No. 428-67918, which includes Valley Boulevard and other streets listed below. This \$10M project is made possible in part by a \$3M Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) grant (from which funding was made available starting in Fiscal Year 2020/2021):

- 1. Valley Boulevard (Temple Ave. to Humane Way)
- 2. Orange Grove Avenue (Fairplex Dr. to Casa Vista Dr. and Artesia St. to Arrow Hwy.)
- 3. Park Avenue (Mission Boulevard to Olive Street)
- 4. San Antonio Avenue (County Rd. to Franklin Ave. and Phillips Blvd. to Mission Blvd.)
- 5. McKinley Avenue (Fairplex Dr. to Towne Ave.)

These streets, as well as Humane Way, have recent pavement rehabilitation in addition to new bicycle facilities.




STATE ROUTE-71 NORTHBOUND SOUND WALL CONSTRUCTION

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin construction of a specific component of the Expressway-to-Freeway Conversion project along the northbound lanes of State Route 71 (SR-71) from Rio Rancho Road to Freemont Street. Specifically, construction of a sound wall along the northbound lanes (see map below) will begin Friday, March 11, 2022, from 12:01 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Continuous work will then be performed weekly Monday through Friday through May 2022. During this time, the construction crew will drill for sound wall footings and concrete pouring.

Residents and businesses near SR-71 are advised to anticipate noise and dust associated with construction activities. The schedule is weather permitting, and all dates and times are subject to change.

The City of Pomona asks all drivers for their patience and to please consider using alternate routes during this time.

<u>CALTRANS ANNOUNCES EXTENDED WEEKEND CLOSURE OF NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 57</u>

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces an extended weekend closure of northbound State Route 57 (SR-57) from S Diamond Bar Boulevard to Pathfinder Road for paving work. Closure is scheduled to begin Friday, March 25 through Monday, March 28.

• **Sunday, March 27** from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m.

• Three right lanes closed on northbound SR-57 at Pathfinder Road

Friday, March 25 through Monday, March 28 from 11:59 p.m. to 4 a.m.


• Left lane closed on southbound SR-57 from SR-60/SR-57 connector to Pathfinder Road

Closures are weather permitting and subject to change.

This closure is part of a pavement replacement project to remove and replace concrete slabs in both directions of SR-57 which will enhance ride quality and maximize the service of the roadway.

Residents and businesses located near the freeway are advised to anticipate noise, vibrations, and dust associated with construction activities.

Motorists should expect delays and are strongly advised to use alternate routes. Detours will be posted. Additionally, motorists can check traffic conditions before they leave by visiting the Caltrans <u>Quickmap</u> (<u>quickmap.dot.ca.gov</u>).

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit (The Affordable Connectivity Program replaced the Emergency Broadband Benefit on December 31, 2021) will provide a discount of up to \$30 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.
