

#### POMONA CITY STABLES UPDATE

In the next few weeks, crews will begin the dismantling of the City Stables building at the City Yard. In February 2017, the building suffered a collapse of the roof and walls due to a combination of factors including excessive rain, clogged roof drains, vibrations from the nearby railroad tracks, and the general state of decay of the building. Instead of demolishing the building, the City Council decided to incorporate the City Stables into the new Water Resources Administration Building project. The solution was salvaging as much of the Stables as possible, using the salvaged materials in the reconstruction. The City's Historic Preservation and Water Department Staff will be on site during the deconstruction to ensure the work is done properly.

### REQUEST FOR PUBLIC INPUT - LOCAL ROADWAY SAFETY PLAN

The City's Engineering Staff is working with a transportation consultant (KOA Corporation) to develop a Local Roadway Safety Plan (LRSP). A LRSP provides the framework for identifying, analyzing, and prioritizing roadway safety improvements on local roads. The LRSP development process and content are tailored to local issues and needs. The process results in a prioritized list of issues, risks, actions, and improvements that can be used to reduce fatalities and serious injuries on local roads (FHWA, n.d.). This Citywide plan will address data driven problems with recommended improvements that will potentially be programmed in future capital improvement projects. We are seeking your input to enhance roadway safety.

# STEEL TUBULAR FENCE REPAIR- SAN ANTONIO, NORTH OF LA VERNE AVENUE

The Department of Public Works received notification last month that the existing pedestrian crossing median fence adjacent to Barfield Elementary School was damaged. Gentry Brothers, Inc. has repaired the damaged fence. The crosswalk is now open to the public for use. The Department of Public Works wants to remind drivers to be aware of the posted speed limits and keep our facilities and streets safe for all users.



## TRAFFIC SIGNAL MODIFICATION PROJECT - PHILADELPHIA STREET AT TOWNE AVENUE AND AT GAREY AVENUE

California Professional Engineering, Inc. (CPE) will begin the construction of traffic signal improvements at Philadelphia Street and Towne Avenue and Philadelphia Street and Garey Avenue. The proposed improvements include the addition of left-turn arrows and new LED countdown pedestrian display for all directions, new controller upgrades, underground conduit upgrades, battery backup systems, and LED lighting retrofits. CPE is scheduled to start construction in June 2022 and is expected to be completed by August 2022. Appropriate signage will be in place to inform the public of this project.

Motorists should use alternate routes to avoid this location until work is complete.
