POMONA AWARDED \$5.1M CALIFORNIA VIOLENCE INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION (CALVIP) GRANT-

The City of Pomona has been awarded a \$5.1M California Violence Intervention and Prevention (CalVIP) Grant, issued by the California Board of State and Community Corrections. The CalVIP Grant encourages jurisdictions to develop a local approaches to reduce violence that meet the diverse needs of each Community.

The Pomona Partnership for Violence Prevention and Neighborhood Wellbeing will work to reduce violence in the City of Pomona by establishing an Office of Violence Prevention (OVP) and Neighborhood Wellbeing to coordinate all activities. The Pomona OVP will serve individuals in Pomona who are at highest risk of involvement in violence crime and the community members most directly affected through street outreach, community stakeholder engagement, cognitive behavioral therapy, diversion, employment and job resources, intensive case management, mental health services, and mentoring through credible messengers.

POMONA AWARDED JUDY L. KESEY MEMORIAL FUND GRANT

The City of Pomona has been selected as a recipient of the second annual \$5,000 Judy L. Kelsey Memorial Fund grant to fund summer internships in the City. Named after a longtime California city manager, the grant was established to enable internships for those with a passion for local government.

The City's intern will assist with in-depth research and analysis on warehouse and industrial uses within a specific area of the City. There is growing interest to address the environmental health impacts and land use compatibility of warehousing in the City as part of the City's comprehensive zoning code update. The City's intern will help assess how many warehouses are needed, the impacts of these uses on infrastructure, and additional high-level strategizing.

The Pomona Police Department's checkpoint originally scheduled for this Friday, June 10^{th,} has been cancelled.


PUBLIC WORKS

CONCRETE SHORTAGE

The construction industry is experiencing severe labor and material shortages in many areas, including concrete. This concrete production shortage is affecting projects such as Caltrans' SR-71 Widening Project and the City's ADA Path of Travel project, in addition to private development. Concrete deliveries are generally running 2 to 3 weeks behind schedule. These material shortages, along with other supply chain issues, are resulting in project delays. The City of Pomona is working with Contractors and City Staff, considering alternative materials, where possible, to help keep projects on intended schedules.

WATER RESOURCES

<u>CITY COUNCIL DECLARES LEVEL 2 WATER SUPPLY SHORTAGE</u>; 2-DAY <u>OUTDOOR WATERING</u>

In response to Governor Newsom's March 2022 Executive Order N-7-22 mandating limits on outdoor water use, the City Council has declared a Level 2 Water Supply Shortage. In addition to other items, this action requires residents to limit watering turf to two days per week. Other water use restrictions are outlined on our <u>City website</u>.

The water use limitations impacting most customers is the limitation on irrigating turf to only two days per week, which are outlined below. Additional limitations come from the State's mandates which include prohibiting all




turf irrigation at commercial, industrial, and institutional sites, unless this turf is used for recreational purposes such as at parks and sports fields. Finally, it is important to remember to continue to irrigate your trees to keep them healthy, which is an approved water use.

City staff will be promoting water conservation tips and rebates at most City events. In addition, notices will be provided at the City Hall counters, community centers, Library, Reader Board, City Hall, City Hall TV, and on social media platforms, Facebook and Instagram.

PHASE 1: HYDRATION STATION UPGRADES

In an effort to bring existing drinking fountains up to with Disabilities Americans Act (ADA) standards. replacement fountains are being installed as part of the City's Hydration Station Upgrade project. Water Resources Staff, in collaboration with Parks & Facilities Staff, are working with the City's maintenance contractor, E.L. Engineering Corporation, to replace six drinking fountains. This project will be executed in two phases; phase 1 began this week. Fountain locations for the first phase are identified in the blue circled areas on the map below. The City anticipates that all six fountains will be completed by the end of June 2022.
