WRITING CAMP SHOWCASE

The City of Pomona is committed to combating summer learning loss through a variety of academic and enrichment opportunities for Pomona's youth. Together, Community Services and the University of Riverside's Inland Area Writing Project hosted a two-week summer writing camp to provide 17 youth, entering grades 4th through 6th, the opportunity to explore the craft of writing. The summer writing camp offered youth of all skill levels, the opportunity to learn the process of writing, explore various writing styles and methods, and build self-confidence as a writer in a fun, supportive environment. Through instruction and fieldtrips, youth were provided with opportunities to express themselves with words, cultivate a passion for writing, connect with others, and utilize their skills to further their academic success.

A culminating Writers' Showcase was held on Friday, July 1, 2022, to allow participants to display their work to family, fellow students, and leaders to celebrate youth writing projects.

OUTDOOR & ACTIVE PROGRAM SENDS YOUTH TO NATURE CAMP

The City of Pomona is happy to highlight sending 16 Pomona youth to Nature Camps at the San Dimas Nature Center over the course of three weeks. A collaboration between the City of Pomona and Los Angeles County Parks and Recreation made it possible for Pomona youth to partake in weeklong (Tuesday-Friday) half-day nature based camps, led by Los Angeles County Park Rangers. Campers were provided the opportunity to connect with the outdoors through hiking adventures, cultural arts, and natural history. Transportation to and from the San Dimas Nature Center was provided through City of Pomona Community Services staff. This program is funded through Pomona Unified School District's Outdoor and Active Youth Program.

BLOOMBERG HARVARD SUMMER FELLOW – RESEARCH ON COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT BEST PRACTICES

For the summer of 2022, the City applied for and received a grant from the Bloomberg Harvard City Leadership Initiative to support a summer fellow for 10 weeks to research best practices for improving resident-city communications. The City was matched with Naomi Robalino as the City's summer Fellow.



About Naomi Robalino:

Naomi is a rising second-year Master of Urban Planning candidate at the Harvard Graduate School of Design. She previously received a Fulbright Award to teach English in South Korea for 3 years and worked in higher education research before moving abroad. She has also had two years of experience in community organizing while working at an affordable housing non-profit and supporting community land trust efforts in Chapel Hill, North Carolina. At the GSD, Naomi is the co-facilitator for the Participatory Budgeting

project through the Healthy Places Design Lab. She currently holds a BA in Public Policy and Global Studies from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Summer Project

Naomi is working on a community outreach strategic engagement plan for the city to guide meaningful and robust community outreach. From May 31-August 4, 2022, Naomi will be interviewing various stakeholders, such as local organizations, City Staff, City Council Members and Commissioners to identify current opportunities and constraints related to community outreach. Additionally, Naomi is looking into best practices and lessons learned from other California municipalities on how to improve online and offline communications with residents. The City hopes to utilize the research to guide the creation of a future strategic engagement plan.


DISTRICT 1 AREA COMMANDER MEETING

PHASE 1: HYDRATION STATION UPGRADES

Water Resources staff in conjunction with Parks & Facilities secured an agreement with the City's maintenance contractor E.L. Engineering Corporation for the replacement of 6 drinking fountains as part of the Phase 1 Hydration Station Upgrades project.
