#### SUMMER BEAUTIFICATION YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

The City is proud to offer 16 high school youth, ages 14-17 years old, the unique opportunity to be a part of the Pomona Summer Beautification Youth Program. As official City staff, Jr. Recreation Leaders are participating in a 4-week program that began July 11, 2022 through August 4, 2022, working two days per week, up to 16 hours a week. # **FINANCE**

#### <u>POMONA TO RESUME REGULAR UTILITY SERVICE PAYMENT</u> PRACTICES

Effective August 1, 2022, the City of Pomona will resume regular utility service payment and disconnection practices for delinquent customer accounts. Throughout the

pandemic emergency, the City has made every effort to assist customers who have experienced difficulties paying their utility bill by:

- Suspended late payment penalties from March 2020 through June 2021.
- Suspended utility shutoffs for nonpayment from March 2020 through July 31, 2022.
- Utilized grant funds awarded by the State Water Resources Control Board to provide almost \$1,000,000 in credits to delinquent accounts.

The Payment/Shut-off timeline information is provided below:

- 1. The City provides customers with billing statements every 61 days.
- 2. Customers have 3 weeks or 21 days from the billing date to pay their water bill.
- 3. If payment is not received on the 21st day, the City will assess a 5% penalty on the total outstanding balance and the customer will be issued a past due notice on the 22nd day.
- 4. Delinquent bills must be paid by the 80th day after the billing date (postmarks are not acceptable) to avoid further penalties and service disconnection.

We understand the uncertainty and financial challenges that many households and commercial establishments are currently facing. Given these unique and unprecedented circumstances, we are offering impacted individuals and businesses the opportunity to request payment arrangements. #### **POLICE**

#### **NATIONAL NIGHT OUT**

On August 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Pomona Police Department with be hosting National Night Out at 400 Civic Center Plaza from 4:00pm-8:00pm. National Night Out is an event which has been held annually since 1984, and is sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch in the United States. National Night Out began simply with neighbors turning on their porch lights and sitting in front of their homes. It is now an event in which everyone is invited to gather for wholesome family fun in an effort to build a stronger

community. The event is meant to increase awareness about police programs in communities, such as <u>drug prevention</u>, <u>town watch</u>, <u>neighborhood watch</u>, and other anti-<u>crime</u> efforts. This year's event will include cookouts, live music, community partner exhibits as well as Police Department, Fire Department, and paramedic safety demonstrations for all in attendance. #### **PUBLIC WORKS**

#### **SR-71 FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE**

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will conduct a full freeway closure in support of the SR-71 Widening Project. Crown Castle (the contractor) will drop an overhead line across the SR-71 freeway during this closure. The closure will be active on Thursday, July 28, 2022, between 10:00 p.m. through 2:00 a.m. for approximately half an hour in both northbound and southbound directions of the SR-71.

Residents and businesses near the freeway are advised to anticipate delays, noise, vibrations, and dust with construction activities.

The City of Pomona asks all drivers to be patient and consider using alternate routes.

Detours will be posted.

#### FULL STREET CLOSURE - GAREY AVENUE

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line Project, Kiewit-Parsons, a joint venture (KPJV), crews will be working at the Garey Avenue railroad crossing to replace the existing Metrolink track. After the KPJV crew replaces the existing Metrolink track, they will work on repaving the work zone. This will result in a full closure of Garey Avenue at the railroad crossing beginning Friday, July 29 at 7:00 a.m. to Tuesday, August 2, 2022, at 7:00 a.m. KPJV workers work around the clock, 24 hours a day, during this time.

#### **Detour Routes (Green Arrows seen on the map below):**


- Towne Avenue (Northbound and southbound) will be the main detour route
- Arrow Highway (Eastbound and Westbound) will remain open to all traffic
- Bonita Avenue (Eastbound and Westbound) will remain open

Access to homes and businesses on Garey Avenue within the closure area north and south of the railroad crossing will be maintained at all times, as well as access to the Metrolink station from Fulton Road and Arrow Highway/Pine Street (blue spaced lines on the map below).

Residents and businesses located near the Garey Avenue rail crossing, between Arrow Highway and Bonita Avenue, are advised to anticipate noise.

Later in the year, KPJV crews will close Garey Avenue again to complete the crossing reconstruction for the new light rail system. More information will be provided in the future.
