SB 1383 - Preparing for New Statewide Mandatory Organic Waste Collection Regulation



What is the new law?

The California State Legislature passed Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) which requires cities and counties to reduce organic waste disposal by 75% by 2025. Beginning January 1, 2022, all California residents, businesses, and multi-family complexes will be required to separate food waste and yard waste from their trash and recycle cart in a separate organics cart.



SB 1383 Goal: Reduce organic materials going to the landfill, decrease greenhouse gas emissions, a and slow climate change.

In an effort to reduce Food Waste, the City is providing organic waste collection service to all residential customers. EASY steps to comply with SB 1383 State Organics Recycling Mandates

- 1. Every resident must comply with the new requirements
- 2. <u>Avoid placing food waste in the black container</u>
- 3. Separate food scraps into a compostable bag
- 4. Yard and bagged Food Waste are to be placed in the green container
