METROLINK LAUNCHES DISCOUNT PROGRAM FOR LOW-INCOME TRAIN RIDERS

Metrolink passengers with a California Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card are eligible for a 50 percent <u>discount</u> on all Metrolink <u>tickets and passes</u>. Riders can use their EBT card at any Metrolink station ticket machine to validate and unlock the discount.

Funding for the discount is made possible by a grant from the Low Carbon Transit Operations Program (LCTOP), administered by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

POMONA PUBLIC LIBRARY AWARDED OVER \$6 MILLION IN GRANT FUNDING

The City is proud to announce the California State Library has awarded the Pomona Public Library \$6,014,328 in grant funding for critical Library infrastructure upgrades. This funding will be utilized to replace the Library roof; completely upgrade Library HVAC equipment, systems and automation controls; and implement various other lighting, energy-efficiency and patron comfort enhancements.



During the week of September 20-26, there will be limited access to the Library's Children's Room for new carpet and flooring installation.



POMONA PD ASSIST PERSON EXPERIENCING MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS

This week, our officers were able to network with one of our community based organizations who encountered a person who, based on family statements, was believed to be a victim of human trafficking. It was determined the individual had been assaulted and was experiencing a mental health crisis due to injury sustained to their head. We were able to verify the victim's name and location, and determined the person was experiencing a mental health crisis. They were connected with professionals from the Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health, as well as with our officers assigned to the Mental Health Evaluation Unit. Officers were able to secure housing, proper mental health care and concluded the person was not a victim of human trafficking. The person is no longer experiencing homelessness and is now receiving treatment for their mental illness. The Pomona Police Department is grateful for the positive relationships and trust we have with our community based organizations.
