

WEEKEND CLOSURE OF SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 57

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announced an extended weekend closure of southbound State Route 57 (SR-57) from the SR-57/SR-60

Interchange to Pathfinder Road for paving work. The closure is scheduled to begin Friday, September 16 through Monday, September 19, 2022.

The closures are as follows:

1. <u>Full closure of southbound SR-57 from SR-57/SR-60 Interchange to</u> Pathfinder Road:


- From 10:00 p.m. on Friday, September 16 to 6:00 a.m. Saturday, September 17, 2022
- From 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 18 to 5:00 a.m. on Monday, September 19, 2022

2. <u>Up to 3 lanes open on southbound SR-57 from SR-60 Interchange to</u> Pathfinder Road.

• From 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 17 to 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 18, 2022

This closure is part of a pavement replacement project to remove and replace concrete slabs in both directions of SR-57, which will enhance ride quality and maximize the service of the roadway.


Residents and businesses located near the freeway are advised to anticipate noise, vibrations, and dust associated with the construction activities. Motorists should expect delays and are strongly advised to use alternate routes. Detours will be posted.



55-HOUR WEEKEND CLOSURE OF WESTBOUND SR-60 AT RAMONA AVENUE

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is advising that construction contractors will perform pavement work and lane closures at Ramona Avenue overcrossing in the City of Chino for the \$8.7M State Route 60 (SR-60) as part of their Corridor Improvement Project. A full 55-hour weekend closure will begin at 11:00 p.m.

on Friday, September 23 and continue through 5:00 a.m. on Monday, September 26. This work will require full mainline closures on the westbound SR-60 at Ramona Avenue. Traffic will be detoured at the Ramona Avenue off-ramp back to SR-60. Anticipate traffic delays. Closures are dependent on the contractor receiving proper materials for each job function. Closures may be subject to change or canceled at any time.
