

POMONA TO RESUME REGULAR UTILITY SERVICE PAYMENT PRACTICES

On July 13, 2022, the Finance and Water Department staff met with the Emergency Preparedness Sub-Committee to explain the Utility Billing and Payment Processes, including the reimplementation of disconnections via a soft disconnect approach.

Community outreach took place via the City Manager's Weekly Message, social media blasts, website news posting, and bill messages. The message included the information that effective August 1, 2022, the City of Pomona would resume regular utility service payment and a soft disconnection practice for delinquent customer accounts.

We are now at the stage for disconnections. As of the week of October 10th, customers with delinquent accounts began receiving final notices (blue door hangers) delivered to the service address.

Beginning Monday, October 24, 2022, the delinquent accounts that received the final notices but have not contacted the City to make payments or arrangements will be disconnected. Several accounts have been identified and are scheduled for disconnection. These account holders received multiple billing notices and have not contacted the City to make any type of payment arrangements to ensure continued service.

The City is reviewing all delinquent accounts and identifying accounts with payment arrangements so that disconnections do not occur during this initial round of resumed disconnections. Over the next few months, as we move on into future billing cycles, we will incorporate identifying delinquent payment plans into the account review to be included in the disconnection process.

We understand the uncertainty and financial challenges that many households and commercial establishments are currently facing. Given these unique and unprecedented circumstances, we continue to offer impacted individuals and businesses the opportunity to request payment arrangements and provide information to available programs for payment assistance such as the <u>LIHWAP</u> being offered by the State of California.

MISSION BOULEVARD - REPAVEMENT OF INTERSECTIONS

As part of the Mission Boulevard repaving project from White Avenue to Towne Avenue, All American Asphalt (Contractor), will repave the intersections within the project limits this weekend. The Mission Boulevard intersections to be worked on are at White Avenue, Garey Avenue, Park Avenue, and Towne Avenue.

- Saturday, October 22, 2022 the City Contractor expects to work on White Avenue and Garey Avenue intersections.
- Sunday, October 23, 2022 the City Contractor will complete Park Avenue and Towne Avenue

This work will substantially complete pavement work on Mission Boulevard as part of this project.

The restriping of Mission Boulevard from White Avenue to Towne Avenue will take place in November 2022, after a pavement cure period of approximately two (2) weeks (temperature/weather/etc. dependent).

Please avoid areas of Mission Boulevard this weekend, and follow detours/traffic control.

This schedule is weather-permitting, and all dates and times are subject to change.

Residents and businesses near the intersections are advised to anticipate noise, delays, vibrations, and dust associated with construction activities. Motorists are strongly advised to avoid the area and use alternate routes.

Please drive slowly around construction areas for the safety of the workers and people around the work area.
