#### CONSOLIDATED PLAN COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Community Engagement and Outreach efforts have officially begun for development of the City's next 5-Year Consolidated Plan. All residents are invited to join upcoming Community Needs Meeting to share your thoughts on funding priorities for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME), and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) Programs.

The kick-off date for community engagement activities began with a Community Needs Survey going live via the City's website on October 25, 2022. The Community Needs Survey can be found at <u>Your Voice Counts Pomona!</u> or <u>Tu Voz Cuenta Pomona!</u>. Additionally, the City released a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) on October 27, 2022 for Community Based Organizations (CBOs) requesting CDBG funds to assist in meeting priority community needs.

The next Community Engagement meeting will be held <u>on November 9, 2022 at</u> 6:30pm at John F. Kennedy Park Community Center.

We encourage all residents to come out and receive information on the process to develop the Consolidated Plan, as well as to provide valuable input on how these federal funds should be prioritized and allocated. #### 7th ANNUAL "BEST HAUNTED HOUSE EVER!" AT PALOMARES PARK

The Community Services Division hosted its 7th annual "best Haunted House ever" according to many participants who attended the free, spooky event at Palomares Park on Friday, October 28th and Saturday, October 29th. The Haunted House event welcomed 980 attendees on Friday and 1,109 attendees on Saturday, for a total of 2,089 attendees that came through the registration table and checked in! Given that an estimated 10% may not have registered, this event welcomed approximately about 2,300 attendees between both evenings! This is an approximate 53% increase from last year's event that had welcomed an estimated 1,500 attendees!

Attendees enjoyed the popular and creepy indoor, walkthrough maze featuring spooky rooms, scary props, and spectacular special effects all designed to offer a thrilling time. The family-friendly area offered trunk-or-treating, a costume contest, music, games, crafts, and face painting.


#### HEALTHY PARENTING - FREE 3 WEEK WORKSHOP!

#### MISSION BOULEVARD - REPAVEMENT OF INTERSECTION

As part of the Mission Boulevard repaving project from White Avenue to Towne Avenue, All American Asphalt (Contractor) will repave the intersection as indicated below:

• Saturday, November 5, 2022, 4 a.m. – 4 p.m. - the City Contractor will complete the intersection of Park Avenue and Mission Boulevard.

This work will substantially complete pavement work on Mission Boulevard as part of this project.

The restriping of Mission Boulevard from White Avenue to Towne Avenue will take place in November, after a pavement cure period of approximately two (2) weeks (temperature/weather/etc. dependent).

Please avoid this area of Mission Boulevard this weekend, and follow detours/traffic control.

This schedule is weather-permitting, and all dates and times are subject to change.

Residents and businesses near the intersections are advised to anticipate noise, delays, vibrations, and dust associated with construction activities. Motorists are strongly advised to avoid the area and use alternate routes.

Please drive slowly around construction areas for the safety of the workers and people around the work area.
