
TEAMWORK MAKES THE DREAM WORK


ELVES ON THE SHELF ARE BACK!


PERMANENT CLOSURE – SANTA FE STREET AND MAGNOLIA STREET

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line Project, crews will be permanently closing Santa Fe Street and Magnolia Street between Garey Avenue and Pine Street in the City of Pomona. Both streets are being permanently closed to become part of the future parking facility for the Pomona Gold Line Station, which is now under construction. Access to the Metrolink Station/parking will be maintained via Grevillia Street, Pine Street, Fulton Road, and Arrow Highway. This permanent closure of Santa Fe Street and Magnolia Street between Garey Avenue and Pine Street will begin Monday, December 5th.

Detour Routes (See Green arrows on the map below):

- Santa Fe Street and Magnolia Street will be fully closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic between Garey Avenue and Pine Street.
- Pine Street (Northbound and Southbound) will remain open to all traffic.
- Grevillia Street and Arrow Highway (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.
- Fulton Road (northbound entrance to the Metrolink Station) will remain open to all traffic.

Permanent closure signage will be placed on Garey Ave and Pine Street to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please follow signage.

<u>PHILLIPS RANCH VIRTUAL COMMUNITY MEETING – DECEMBER 8 AT 6</u> PM

If you are a resident of Phillips Ranch, the City invites you to attend this important meeting to learn more about the assessment homeowners pay to fund landscaping and lighting. Since the District was formed in 1990, costs have risen significantly, while the assessment rates have remained unchanged for 32 years. This has resulted in maintenance reductions and aging infrastructure.

The assessment was intended to pay for the following:

- Irrigation repairs and improvements
- Preservation of 203 acres of open space
- Weed abatement
- Greenbelt amenities
- Bee and rodent control
- Fire safety
- Wood fencing, monuments, and walls
- Tree maintenance
- Maintenance of 40 acres of turf

The City has been aware of a severe budget deficit for the Phillips Ranch Landscape Maintenance District (District) for several years. The City is faced with an almost complete depletion of the reserves and a \$410,000 deficit in this fund. In order to mitigate this situation, the City is preparing for another Proposition 218 ballot measure to increase the assessment. The City has hired a consultant to determine and justify the rate increase, and it is anticipated that a new voting opportunity will be placed on a ballot in the Spring of 2023. In the meantime, the City is forced to consider a drastic reduction and/or a total elimination of many landscape maintenance services, including tree maintenance, landscape maintenance, and watering totaling \$410,000.
