




OUTDOOR & ACTIVE TAKES YOUTH TO CAL POLY BASKETBALL GAME

PUBLIC WORKS

FREEWAY CLOSURE - CALTRANS REPAIRING POTHOLES ON NORTHBOUND SR71

As part of the ongoing efforts to keep the roads and highways operational during the construction of the SR71 Widening Project, Caltrans will continue to repair potholes. This operation will require a full freeway closure of the northbound SR71 on Thursday, January 12, 2023 from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. The closures will also include closure of the westbound 60 freeway connector to the northbound SR71; and the Rio Rancho offramps, as well as mainline closures. Detours will be provided for motorists.

SOCALGAS GAS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR INCOME QUALIFIED POMONA RESIDENTS
