COMMUNITY SERVICES

2023 CALIFORNIA PARKS & RECREATION SOCIETY (CPRS) CONFERENCE AND EXPO

Community Services' recreation Staff will be attending the 2023 CPRS Conference and Expo on April 3-6, 2023 at the San Diego Convention Center. The conference is known for innovative educational sessions, forums, and networking opportunities, while the

Expo brings together hundreds of industry-leading vendors and exhibitors. For years, the CPRS Conference and Expo has been a valuable training and networking opportunity for California-based recreation Staff in the public sector. Due to financial constraints, City Staff did not attend for many years following the recession. Community Services is dedicated to promoting staff development, innovation, and collaboration and has prioritized attendance at this conference for key staff members. This will be the first time the team has attended since 2020.

Eight team members from Neighborhood Services / Community Services and four Staff members from Public Works will be attending the conference to learn how the City can continue to improve Pomona's parks and programming. Additionally, five Community Service Staff will attend a one-day intensive training at CPRS. Recreation Staff are most excited to develop, promote, and support innovative park programming to promote healthy communities and improve the quality of life in Pomona.

OUTDOOR & ACTIVE HOSTS WINTER BASKETBALL TOURNMENT

City of Pomona is celebrating the All-Star "B" and "C" division basketball teams. After a season of basketball programming, participants were able to experience two weeks of intensive practices at PUSD's Fremont Academy of Engineering and Design. As a pilot program, City Staff and participants were welcomed into Fremont's gym, as the rainy weather made it difficult to have practices outside. The collaboration with PUSD is appreciated and was a special experience for youth because participants typically practice outside in Pomona's parks since the City does not own and operate an indoor basketball gym.





INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

CYBERSECURITY UPDATE

Securing the City of Pomona's IT infrastructure remain IT's primary focus. To ensure we are safe from the latest known vulnerabilities, the IT team upgraded 5 firewalls for City Hall and the Police Department. Additionally, we have decommissioned another 2 obsolete servers for a total of 7 servers this year and upgraded 2 video appliances' operating systems. IT is also reassessing its DMZ (Demilitarized Zone) configurations for opportunities to further strengthen the security of our servers. DMZ is a perimeter network traditionally used to protect servers that are accessible by the public (e.g. websites) from allowing untrusted traffic into the internal local network.










MAJOR CRIMES TASK FORCE UNIT SHUTS DOWN ANOTHER ILLEGAL CASINO AND MARIJUANA DISPENSARY

On March 9th, officers from the Pomona Police Department were dispatched to a vacant commercial property at 761 Corporate Center Drive in reference to an embezzlement investigation regarding the property. During the initial investigation, officers discovered an illegal casino that was being run inside the vacant property without the knowledge or permission of the property owner. While checking the remainder of the building, members of our Major Crimes Task Force discovered an illegal marijuana dispensary containing multiple types of marijuana products. After authoring a search warrant for the location, we seized approximately 1,500 pounds of marijuana product. The current estimated market value for this amount of marijuana and marijuana products is approximately 1.3 million dollars.


HEART OF THE FOOTHILLS

Celebrate Earth Month on Sunday, April 23, 2023, when Golden Streets "Heart of the Foothills" returns to the cities of Claremont, Pomona, La Verne, and San Dimas for the first time in five years. Made possible by Metro Los Angeles' Open Streets program, in coordination with the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments (SGVCOG) and ActiveSGV, "Heart of the Foothills" will connect downtown Claremont, Pomona, San Dimas, and La Verne via a route primarily following Bonita Avenue and Arrow Highway. Thanks to the cooperation from each partnering city, attendees will have the opportunity to walk, bike, run, skate, scoot, and dance across this 6.5-mile car free route.

Like cicLAvia in Los Angeles, Heart of the Foothills is a FREE, family-friendly "ciclovia" that temporarily opens streets for people of all ages and backgrounds to enjoy in a healthy, fun, and novel fashion. The festivities will kick off at 8:30 a.m. with an official Opening Ceremony along the event route at Palomares Park in Pomona, that will feature special guests, music, and free event t-shirts for the first 50 attendees.

Attendees can start and stop at any point along the route, at any time from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Activity zones in each participating community will host live music, cultural performances, family-friendly games and activities, green vendors, zero-emission demo zones, and more! Participants are encouraged to enjoy the day by foot, bike, skate, skateboard, scooter, or any other form of active mobility. San Gabriel Valley residents in need of a bicycle for the day may reserve a GoSGV pedal-assist electric bicycle for pickup






WATER RESOURCES

GOLD LINE - ARROW HWY. & E ST. WATER MAIN CONSTRUCTION

Last week, the Metro Gold Line Authority finalized the 30" City of Pomona's water main improvements design. The existing 30" steel main is a section of the Pomona-Walnut-Rowland (PWR) transmission import water main. The existing 30" water main improvements began March 13, 2023. The work will be completed before the second week of April. The Gold Line Authority is managing all traffic control and associated permitting for the area. The work area is adjacent to the proposed City of La Verne Gold Line station platform.
