
CYBERSECURITY UPDATE

SUMMER READING EVENT - WEEK 2




SCHEDULED SR-71 FREEWAY CLOSURES

As part of the ongoing effort to keep the roads and highways operational during the construction of the SR-71 Widening Project, Caltrans will transfer conductors on the overhead pass to new poles. This project will require night freeway closures, as follows:

• Friday, June 16, 2023 to Saturday, June 17, 2023

- 1. Westbound 60 connector to northbound 71 will be closed from 7:00 pm 10:00 am.
- 2. Northbound 71 off-ramp at Mission Blvd. will be closed from 7:00 pm 3:00 pm.
- 3. Northbound 71 on-ramp at Rio Rancho Rd. will be closed from 7:00 pm 3:00 pm.
- 4. Northbound 71 off-ramp at Rio Rancho Rd. will be closed from 9:00 pm 10:00 am.
- 5. Westbound 60 to northbound 71 at Mission Blvd. will be closed from 10:00 pm 6:00 am.
- 6. Northbound 71 on-ramp at Garey Ave. will be closed from 7:00 pm 3:00 pm.
- 7. Southbound 71 from Mission Blvd. to eastbound 60 will be closed from 11:00 pm 7:00 am.
- 8. Southbound 71 on-ramp at Mission Blvd. will be closed from 7:00 pm 3:00 pm.
- 9. Southbound 71 on-ramp at Rio Rancho Rd. will be closed from 7:00 pm 12 pm.
