This week, the IT team deployed new networking equipment at the Pomona Public Library that includes a modern firewall and several wireless access points for Library patrons. The new hardware upgrade further protects patrons and City of Pomona's digital infrastructure by hardening our cybersecurity posture with the latest definitions of attack vectors, as well as improves Wi-Fi connection speed and bandwidth. 
CELL'IN WELL

Where cost-effective and reliable internet is unavailable to the City of Pomona at some facilities, IT is finding innovative ways to work past such obstacles. After rigorous research and testing, PDIT deployed a cellular solution to such facility with industrial-grade antenna that resulted in a whopping 300Mbps download speed! This deployment now enables PD staff at this remote location to have reliable and quality access to the internet and internal network resources. A similar solution was also deployed to the PD Mobile Command Center to improve cellular signal strength and performance by leveraging both 4G and 5G band frequencies.
