INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

COMMUNITY CENTER INTERNET UPDATE

Since our last update in March, we upgraded La Casita's internet from 5Mbps to 500Mbps. This new high-speed internet will formally be put to use in the computer lab upon successful burn-in tests. IT also successfully worked with a local internet provider to bring cost-effective high-speed internet to Ganesha, Jaycee, and Willie White Community Centers. The installation may take up to a few months to complete due to potential capital work needed by the provider, however, this hard-wired connection is much preferred over the cellular-based alternative that IT was prepared to deploy. Having addressed internet access for the community centers, the IT team is now standardizing network configurations for each facility. Lastly, IT is preparing new computers to update existing computer labs and to introduce computers to community centers that were not equipped with them. Check back for more updates!

CYBERSECURITY UPDATE

IT's focus remains on our partnership with Department of Homeland Security's cybersecurity arm, CISA, by utilizing their report to prioritize our cybersecurity initiatives. In the last couple of weeks, the team reduced another nine vulnerabilities. Besides standard routine maintenance to patch all IT hardware and software for zero-day vulnerabilities, the team also completed upgrades on all 12 Network Video Recorders (NVRs) to use a modern operating system.

AMPING UP EFFICIENCY

Late last year, IT collaborated with the Finance Department to streamline Southern California Edison (SCE) billing processes by adopting SCE's E-Summary feature to group the City of Pomona's accounts. In December, 345 of the 510 locations were successfully grouped together and have since freed staff from needing to enter hundreds of accounts manually. As of last week, IT and Finance completed the grouping of the remaining 165 locations and fully streamlined the process. Check back to see "watt" else IT is working on!

LOW INCOME HOUSEHOLD WATER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The State of California may be able to help with past due water bills. Visit https://csd.ca.gov/waterbill to see if you qualify and to apply. The federal funds will only be available until August 31, 2023.

The City has been enrolled in the California Department of Community Services & Development LIHWAP since June of 2022. The program is a federally funded program that offers low-income households a one-time payment (up to \$2,000) to help pay outstanding bills for residential water or wastewater costs.

Since the program launched in the summer of 2022, 148 Pomona customers have applied for assistance, and their accounts have been paid in full totaling \$157,308.77.

To make the questionnaire as inclusive as possible, it is available in six different languages: English, Spanish, Chinese, Vietnamese,

Developed through a collaborative partnership between Metropolitan Water District and the Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts, Pure Water Southern California would increase the reliability of regional water supplies by recycling and purifying water that currently flows to the ocean. The program would produce up to 150 million gallons of water daily, making it one of the world's largest purified water projects.
