
During the Plenary Session, Jack Dangermond (President of Esri) highlighted usersubmitted project photos to the 18,000 in-person and 20,000+



PUBLIC WORKS

<u>STREET PRESERVATION PROJECT UPDATE – MAIN STREET PROJECT NO. 428-68582</u>

Hardy & Harper, Inc. (Contractor) will begin planned street preservation improvements on Main St., north of the railroad tracks, between First St. and Monterey Ave. Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. beginning on Monday, July 24th with completion anticipated by Wednesday, July 26th, as weather permits. During this time, traffic detours can be expected which may impact bus services. The contractor will coordinate access to the neighboring Foothill Transit Center on Main St. and allow limited bus operation during construction as follows: bus pick up/drop offs will use Parcels St. and Commercial St. instead of the transit center. "No Parking" signs will be posted in affected areas. Rail service will remain. Please exercise caution during this time.

HOLT CORRIDOR PROJECT CONSTRUCTION

The Holt Corridor Project has begun! The Project will create new raised landscaped medians on Holt Avenue from Garey Avenue to San Antonio Avenue (or to Towne Avenue, if funds allow), and improve and beautify parkways along Holt Avenue from Garey Avenue to Mills Avenue. Limited work of a similar nature is also included along Garey Avenue from Holt Avenue to Mission Boulevard. Also included with this Project will be improvements at Garfield Park to include a new perimeter walking path, new lighting, and new exercise equipment. Construction is scheduled to be completed in Spring 2024.

The City received a \$4.9 million Clean CA grant to help fund this nearly \$8 million Project, and this grant requires the accelerated schedule noted above. The City's Contractor for this Project is Vido Smarzich, Inc.

EMERGENCY WATERLINE REPLACEMENT

The Mt. SAC Facilities Planning and Management Department is conducting an emergency project to replace an existing 12" main waterline that runs under Temple Avenue. The waterline is approximately 1 mile long between Cal Poly Pomona and Mt. SAC (please see attached map below). Construction began on July 13, 2023, and is expected to be completed by August 28, 2023. Traffic control measures have already been placed on Temple Avenue to reduce vehicular traffic to one lane in the westbound direction at Cal Poly Pomona, as well as, eastbound at Mt. SAC. Expect heavy delays and proceed with caution when approaching construction zones. Please allow extra time to get to your destination and use alternate routes, if possible.
