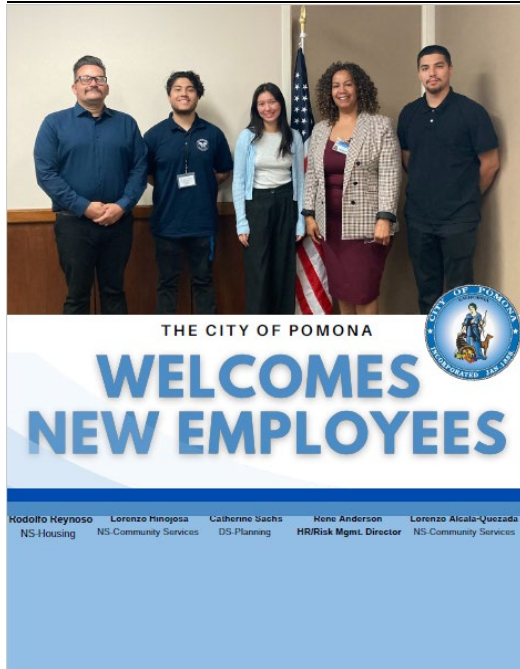

I.T. PHONE HOME

Back in May, IT reported that the City was transitioning to a new telephone service provider and migrated most of our phone numbers. This week, IT is pleased to announce the completion of this initiative. The City Pomona benefits from this project as it modernizes our telephony infrastructure to be more resilient and ready to adopt cloud services in the future. Additionally, there is an anticipated savings of about \$50,000 per year. The expected savings stems primarily from migrating off of legacy copper wire services and on to fiber.

HIGH FIVE FOR WI-FI

IT is making consistent progress on community center Wi-Fi deployment. Having installed Wi-Fi at three different community centers in the past few weeks (Garfield Park, Kiwanis Park, Philadelphia Park), by the end of the week IT anticipates completing Wi-Fi installation at Willie White Community Center. COMMUNITY MEETING AT GANESHA PARK – PROPOSED BIKE PARK – SEPTEMBER 7th at 6 PM

Join us on Thursday, September 7, at 6:00 pm, for a community meeting to hear about a proposed bike park at Ganesha Park and to provide feedback. The proposed bike park could potentially be located in the southwestern portion of Ganesha Park near the intersection of Val Vista Street and Loma Vista Street.

On June 5, 2023, the City Council approved a new Capital Improvement Project named “Casillas Bike Park.” This Project will create a BMX-style bike park that will be named in honor of Pomona Police Officer Gregory Casillas, who was killed in the line of duty on March 9, 2018. The Ganesha Park location is being considered as one potential location in the City for a bike park.

NO WIPES IN THE PIPES CAMPAIGN

Help us wipe out costly and messy sewer problems!




THE PROBLEM: Wipes, rags, paper towels, and other materials are being flushed into the sewer system, causing serious problems for our wastewater maintenance crews.

THE SOLUTION: Flush only toilet paper and human waste – nothing else! If you use wipes, **Trash'em, Don't flush 'em!**

A Threat to Your Pipes (and Pocketbook) too: If wipes and other materials can clog our large sewer pipes, they can definitely clog your home's much smaller pipes, requiring you to pay a plumber to clear the blockage.

HELP SPREAD THE WORD: At home, tell your family members to flush only toilet paper, nothing

else. At work, you can help by posting notices in bathrooms and other places where paper towels, wipes, or rags might be used or disposed of. Advise people to **“Trash'em, don't flush 'em!”**
