COMMUNITY CENTERS – IT UPDATES

IT is excited to announce another successful deployment of five new community computers at Renacimiento Community Center. In addition to the new computers, we also deployed Community Wi-Fi and upgraded the center’s internet from 100Mbps to 500Mbps! This is the City’s 10th and final community center computer deployment that started with John F. Kennedy, Philadelphia, Ralph Welch, Westmont, Garfield, Kiwanis, Jaycee, Willie White, and La Casita Teen Community Centers. The refresh includes larger monitor screens with built-in web cameras to support virtual conferencing and computers equipped with Microsoft Office suite for community use. GIS APPLICATION

GIS team successfully upgraded the second GIS Enterprise system last weekend for City Hall. The upgrade includes added cybersecurity, improved performance, and introduced new functionalities. SCHEDULED SR-71 FREEWAY CONNECTOR AND ON-RAMP CLOSURES

As part of the ongoing efforts to keep the roads and highways operational, Caltrans will implement various closures along the State Route 71 (SR-71) through Friday, May 17, 2024 for road repair work.

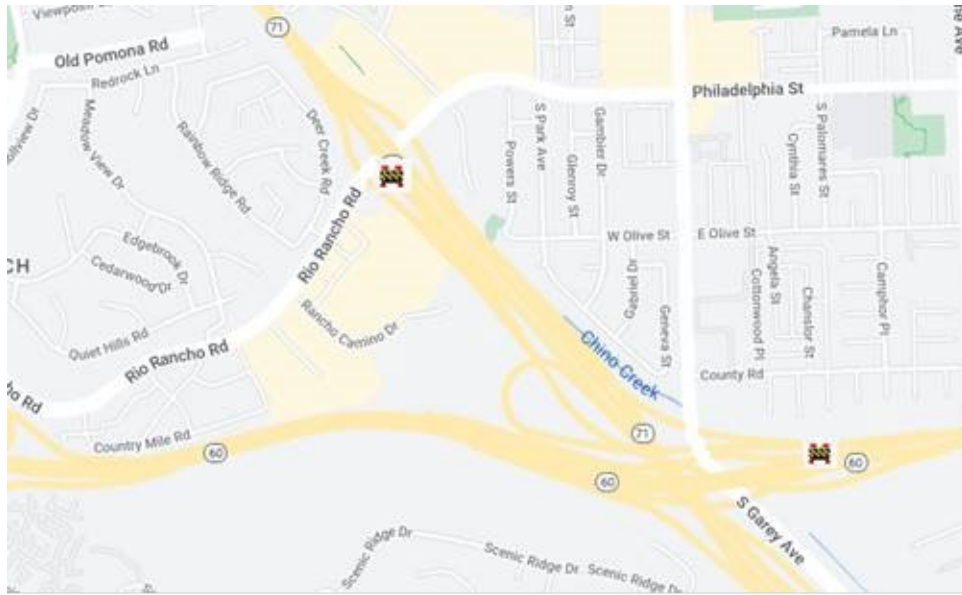
