
COUNCIL MEETING – CAPTIONING PILOT

Having launched the City of Pomona's High Definition (HD) Public Educational Governmental channel (PEG) back in January and initiated our first captioning pilot in March, IT made steady progress in improving English captioning for web stream (https://live.pomonaca.gov) and TV broadcast (Spectrum channel #1301) since then. The fine-tuning of the English captioning engine for Pomona-specific landmarks and street names (e.g. Towne instead of Town, Garey instead of Gary) has proven consistent but will still require further monitoring. Spanish captioning pilot will also begin which can be accessed at https://live.pomonaca.gov > Spanish Channel (at bottom of page) > Watch button. The Spanish translator's audio is expected to be streamed on the web and broadcasted over SAP (Secondary Audio Programming) on TV. The translator's audio will also be used for closed captioning on web stream and CC3 for broadcast. Please refer to your cable TV provider's instruction manual on enabling SAP and CC3. Stay "tuned-in" for more updates!


FIELD DAY AT ALCOTT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WATER RESOURCES PHASE #3: HYDRATION STATION UPGRADES

On February 26, 2023, the City Council awarded a contract to Oppenheimer National to upgrade non-functioning drinking fountains and to bring existing drinking fountains up to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. The project scope will include the replacement of ten drinking fountains and relocating two. Work for the "Hydration Station Upgrades" project will begin in June. This project is the last phase of the project. Previously installed locations and the current phase of locations are identified in the map on the following page. It is anticipated that installation work for all 12 drinking fountains will be completed by the end of September 2024.
