PUBLIC WORKS SR-71 FREEWAY CONNECTOR AND ON - RAMP CLOSURES

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has announced various closures of State Route 71 (SR-71) between State Route 60 (SR-60) on Monday, June 24 through Friday, June 28 for road repair work. EXTENDED CLOSURE – The Rio Rancho on-ramp to Northbound SR-71 will be closed from June 10, 2024 through September 30, 2024 for ramp realignment. Detours will be posted.


Friday, June 28
